#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR PRIZES**

All fish must be presented via a photo on an approved brag mat. Photos will be scrutinised by the Weighmaster, who may adjust the length claimed or reject the photo totally. Brag mats may be purchased from the club for \$10 at the briefing.

FISHING AREAS Bega River estuary, Merimbula Lake and Merimbula Back Lake & Pambula Lake and Rivers, upstream from their mouths.	FISHING METHODS Fish must be caught by rod and reel, and comply with NSW DPI Fisheries regulations. Note for this Comp. we specify 300mm to the fork as the minimum for Australian Salmon.
FISHING TIMES Fishing activity can commence at <b>5.00</b> am Saturday 2 <sup>nd</sup> of Dec. All record sheets must be at the clubhouse and signed by the Weighmaster no later than <b>3.00</b> pm on Sunday 3 <sup>rd</sup> Dec.	NOMINATION OF DELEGATE  If entrants know they cannot be at the presentation, they may nominate a delegate, with the organiser, at the briefing.  This will be certified on their record sheet.
RECORD SHEET  Anglers are required to fill in the date, time of capture and lengths as specified for all legal length fish.	OFFICIAL MEASURING STATION All photos and record sheets <u>must be</u> at the MBGLAC clubrooms by 3.00pm on Sunday 3 <sup>rd</sup> Dec. Weighmaster available from 2.00pm.
FISH MEASUREMENT Fish are judged by length, not weight. All fish are measured from the tip of the nose to the <b>fork</b> of the tail with the exception of dusky flathead and jewfish which are measured to the <b>end</b> of the tail.	PRESENTATION  The presentation will be held at the MBGLAC clubrooms at approx. <b>4.00pm</b> on Sunday 3 <sup>rd</sup> Dec. There will be giant raffle and complimentary Sausage Sizzle. Additional prizes may be awarded at the Committee's discretion.

Attendance at the Friday night (1<sup>st</sup> Dec) clubhouse tournament briefing is required for each competitor, so that entry can be verified.
